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BRIEF HISTORY

The ISO Recommendation R 1145, *Dimensions of refractory arch bricks*, was drawn up by Technical Committee ISO/TC 33, *Refractories*, the Secretariat of which is held by the British Standards Institution (BSI).

Work on this question led to the adoption of a Draft ISO Recommendation.

In December 1967, this Draft ISO Recommendation (No. 1439) was circulated to all the ISO Member Bodies for enquiry. It was approved, subject to a few modifications of an editorial nature, by the following Member Bodies :
