## **National foreword**

This standard has been prepared by ECISS/TC 13 "Flat products for cold working – Qualities, dimensions, tolerances and specific tests" (Secretariat: Belgium).

The responsible German body involved in its preparation was the *Normenausschuss Eisen und Stahl* (Steel and Iron Standards Committee), Technical Subcommittee UA 20/2 *Maßnormen für kaltgewalzte Flacherzeugnisse*.

### **Amendments**

This standard differs from DIN EN 10140:1996-10 as follows:

- a) In Table 1, subclause 6.1 thickness tolerances for nominal widths  $\geq 125$  mm up to 600 mm have been combined.
- b) If so agreed at the time of ordering, the upper limit of a 600 mm nominal width can be extended to 650 mm.
