The reason for this vote by the UK Technical subcommittee FW/0/2, Domestic and Contract Furniture is due to concerns that the test dummy defined in clause 4.1 might not be suitable for all types of reclining chair.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted by Technical Committee FW/0, Furniture, to subcommittee FW/0/2, Domestic and Contract Furniture.
