This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 60335-2-86:2003+A12:2017. It is derived from IEC 60335-2-86:2002, incorporating amendments 1:2005 and 2:2016. It supersedes BS EN 60335-2-86:2003+A2:2016, which is withdrawn.

The start and finish of text introduced or altered by amendment is indicated in the text by tags. Tags indicating changes to IEC text carry the number of the IEC amendment. For example, text altered by IEC amendment 1 is indicated by A1 A1.

The CENELEC common modifications have been implemented at the appropriate places in the text. The start and finish of each common modification is indicated in the text by tags C C.

Where a common modification has been introduced by CENELEC amendment, the tags carry the number of the amendment. For example, the common modifications introduced by CENELEC amendment A11 are indicated by C11 C11.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee CPL/61/8, Farm equipment.
