In comparison with DIN 17 440 and DIN 17441, July 1985 editions, the following amendments have been made.

- Some of the material names have been changed (the corresponding material numbers having been left unchanged).
- Steel grades X15Cr13 (1.4024) and X20CrNi17-2 (1.4057) have been dropped.
- 38 new steel grades have been included.
- The requirements regarding chemical composition, mechanical properties, sampling, scope of testing, marking and heat treatment have been amended.
