This British Standard has been prepared under the direction of the Electronic Equipment Standards Committee and is identical with IEC 98: 1987 'Analogue audio disk records and reproducing equipment', published by the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC).

This standard supersedes BS 1928: 1965 and BS 4852: Part 1: 1972 which are both withdrawn.

Terminology and conventions. The text of the international standard has been approved as suitable for publication as a British Standard without deviation. Some terminology and certain conventions are not identical with those used in British Standards; attention is drawn especially to the following.

References to page numbers in the text relate to the IEC page numbers given in brackets at the bottom of each page.

For the purposes of this standard, the references made in appendix C to BS 1928, which is superseded by this standard, for catalogue numbers TCS 101, TCS 104 and TCS 105 should be read as referring to this British Standard, BS 7063.
