MILITARY SPECIFICATION

HEATERS, SPACE, ELECTRIC: BLOWER, RADIANT AND TURRET  
 (NAVAL SHIPBOARD)

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-H-22663(SHIPS), 15 November 1960.

# Page 1, paragraph 2.1: Delete "STANDARDS MILITARY MIL-STD-105-Sampling Procedures and Tables for Inspection by Attributes."

# Page 1, paragraph 2.2: Add:

"OFFICIAL CLASSIFICATION COMMITTEE  
 Uniform Freight Classification Rules.

(Application for copies should be addressed to the Official Classification Committee, 1 Park Avenue at 33rd Street, New York 16, New York.)"

# Page 5, paragraph 3.9.11.4, line 3: Add "be" after "shall".

# Page 5, paragraph 3.10.5: Delete and substitute:

"3.10.5 Enclosure.- The sides of the heater case shall be of heavy perforated sheet metal. The ends of the enclosure shall be of solid sheet metal. The minimum thickness for sheet metal shall be 0.045 inch. The enclosure shall be such that current carrying parts cannot be readily short circuited by thrusting objects through the sides of the case. It is recommended but not required that enclosures for both 500 and 1000 watt heaters be identical and that the 500 watt rating be obtained by using half the number of heating elements used in the 1000 watt heater. The heater enclosure shall be constructed with fasteners which will allow easy access to the heating element for replacement purposes, and will eliminate end play when end plates are fastened to the expanded metal enclosure."

Page 6, paragraph 3.15: Delete and substitute:

"3.15 No repair parts shall be furnished for type B heaters. For type D and type T heaters, only heating elements in the quantities specified (see 6.2) shall be furnished as repair parts."

Page 6, paragraph 4.1: Delete and substitute:

"4.1 Responsibility for inspection.- Unless otherwise specified in the contract or purchase order, the supplier is responsible for the performance of all inspection requirements as specified herein. Except as otherwise specified, the supplier may utilize his own facilities or any commercial laboratory acceptable to the Government. The Government reserves the right to perform any of the inspections set forth in the specification where such inspections are deemed necessary to assure supplies and services conform to prescribed requirements."
